MUD BOGGING COMPETITION

Sunday, August 13, 2017

OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS:

The Mud Bogging Competition is promoted as a spectator attraction. In the interest of safety, drivers and mechanics are subject to and must obey the rules and regulations, which are set up by the New Jersey State Fair/SCFHS Association, Inc.

- 1. Entries are limited to the first 125 applicants (25 per class)
- 2. Qualified contestants must arrive no later than 10:30am on competition day
- 3. Competition is for four wheel drive vehicles ONLY
- 4. Entry fee is \$30, which includes entry to the Fair for the driver
- 5. General Admission tickets for the Mud Bog Competition are \$6 and can be purchased at the NJ State Fair
- 6. Pit Passes are available at Gate 9 for \$10, which includes entry to the Fair
- 7. Each driver must fill out an entry form. A person may enter more than one class, however, tires must be changed between runs and if vehicle is not ready to go when their number comes up, their entry fee will be forfeited
- 8. Judges and Officials reserve the right to approve or reject any or all entries
- 9. Only owners/drivers who sign a release form and possess a pit pass will be permitted in the competition area. Confirmation and Fair passes will be issued upon the Fair's acceptance of the entry.
- 10. The NJ State Fair/SCFHS Association, Inc will not be responsible for any damage to vehicles or personal property before, during or after the competition. The NJ State Fair will not be responsible for any damages that occur as vehicles are being towed out.
- 11. Please read disclaimer on registration form before signing as it has been changed
- 12. All vehicles MUST be removed from the grounds at the conclusion of the event
- 13. Nitrous oxide systems are prohibited
- 14. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are not permitted
- 15. Any driver or crewmember disobeying the rules will cause his or her entry to be disqualified and their entry fee will be forfeited
- 16. Towing and transporting vehicles to the Fairgrounds must be done in a proper and legal manner
- 17. All drivers must wear a FULL FACE helmet & neck brace, and are required to wear long pants and a shirt during competition (no shorts allowed) NO EXCEPTIONS
- 18. Driver only in arena/competition area NO EXCEPTIONS
- 19. All vehicles must hook to the cable

PREPERATION OF VEHICLES

Vehicle must have an apparatus protruding from the rear on which to attach a clevis hook. Our staff will attach a cable when entrant is competing. This is in the event a vehicle does not go through the entire bog and needs to be towed. At this time we are planning on using a four wheel drive tractor for towing and

expect to keep a cable attached during competition. Vehicle must have a roll bar or some safety construction if it has an open roof. Eye protection is required if vehicle does not have windshield.

5 CLASSES OF VEHICLES

- 4WD vehicles, unaltered DOT tires. Size up to 33 inches in diameter
- 4WD vehicles, unaltered DOT tires. Size up to 33.1 to 36 inches in diameter
- 4WD vehicles, unaltered DOT tires. Size up to 36.1 to 40 inches in diameter
- 4WD vehicles, unaltered DOT tires. Size up to 40.1 to 44 inches in diameter
- 4WD vehicles, Open class, non-DOT or cut tires

Dimensions measured to the nearest 1/10th inch. No dual tires. The diameter of the largest tire on the vehicle determines the class. Based on entry volume, classes may be consolidated. *When running two classes, all four tires must meet the above sizes. All tire sizes must fit class specs.

COMPETITION TRACK

The track is approximately fifteen feet wide and one hundred feet long. There is a start line ten feet before the measured track.

THE COMPETITION

- 1. Vehicle must be equipped with and driver must wear both a seat belt and FULL FACE helmet and neck brace during competition. If vehicle is equipped with a racing harness, driver must wear full harness.
- 2. Vehicle's front wheels are on the start line. Flagman waves a flag and a timer begins. Another flagman is positioned at the end of the track and waves a flag when the vehicle crosses the finish line. Time keeper stops the timer and notes the time (to the nearest tenth of a second) that it took for the vehicle to complete the course.
- 3. If the vehicle fails to complete the course, a judge waves a flag signaling that forward motion has ceased. Time and distance traveled into the mud will be measured to the nearest inch at that point
- 4. If vehicle runs sideways, or out of track, judge will signal driver to stop. Vehicle will be disqualified.
- 5. Winners in each class will be determined based upon fastest completion time.
- 6. In the event that any or all vehicles fail to complete the course, ranking will be based first on distance than on time.
